For November, the group will meet Monday, Nov. 4.

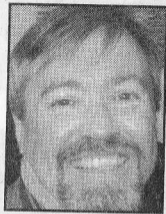
Robert Wilbanks IV will be the featured speaker, talking about the great new potential of lesser-known genealogical resources.
